## Sonnet

A sonnet is a 14-line poem, usually rhyming.

There are lots of different kinds of sonnets. This worksheet matches the rhyming pattern I used in the "F.A.Q. sonnet" on my website: three rhyming quatrains (4 lines each) followed by one rhyming couplet (2 lines).

The letters stand for rhymes at the ends of the lines. An "a" at the end of a line means the line rhymes with another "a" word, a "b" rhymes with another "b" word, etc.
